SLVHD Offers Free and Easy Disposal of Analog TVs Through September 10th

(Salt Lake County) – While it appears that most all residents in Salt Lake County survived the June 14th switch to digital TV signals, many are asking, “Now what?” when they look at the old analog(s) sitting in the garage. The Salt Lake Valley Health Department (SLVHD) wants people to know that, from now until September 10th, they will be making the disposal of old, analog televisions (and all e-waste, for that matter) easier for county residents by accepting electronics at all of their remaining 2009 Summer Community Collection Events (see attached schedule).

Since the beginning of 2009, the SLVHD Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) program has received hundreds of calls from people wondering how and where to dispose of their old sets. Beginning last fall, the SLVHD started accepting e-waste at their HHW facilities located at two county landfills; both of which have experienced ever-increasing amounts of analog television sets.

“We have been receiving literally tons of old television sets since about the first of this year,” explained Dorothy Adams, HHW Program Manager. “The over-whelming interest of people wanting to properly dispose of the old analog TVs – to do the right thing for their community and environment – is so great! It’s one of the reasons we decided to expand our services and accept e-waste at our weekly HHW community collection events.”
