Seasonal Flu Vaccine Available Wednesday, September 2nd *Flu vaccine provides protection against common seasonal strains*

(Salt Lake County) – The Salt Lake Valley Health Department (SLVHD) is announcing that seasonal flu vaccinations will be available Wednesday, September 2nd at their six health centers. Both the traditional injectable shot and FluMist will be available to the general public. The cost is \$20 for the shot and \$25 for FluMist.

Health officials are urging residents to get their seasonal flu shot now, and not to wait until the H1N1 vaccine becomes available later this fall. Pregnant women, young children, the elderly and those with chronic medical conditions are encouraged to get the vaccination as soon as possible.

Centers are open Monday – Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and from 8:30 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. on Wednesday.
