## **Jolley's Pharmacy Locations Join in H1N1 Vaccination Efforts**

*Retail locations increase vaccine access points for public*

(Salt Lake County) – Salt Lake Valley Health Department (SLVHD) officials today announced that two Jolley's Pharmacy locations (in Salt Lake and West Jordan) have joined the health department H1N1 vaccination efforts by providing additional vaccination access points in Salt Lake County.

“It is really great to have Jolley's Pharmacy step forward to help in our efforts,” said Gary Edwards, Executive Director for SLVHD. “With these additions, the combined pharmacy efforts provide over 10,500 vaccinations each week.”

Jolley's joins Harmons Grocery, Smith's Food & Drug and Walgreens locations in Salt Lake County for a total of 52 retail locations offering H1N1 flu vaccinations.

“The more access points there are, the easier it will be for the public to get vaccinated,” Edwards said. “Our goal has always been to vaccinate as many people as quickly as possible, and adding these retail pharmacies is a big step in that direction.”

Pharmacies must abide by the CDC guidelines and can currently vaccinate only individuals that fall within the CDC priority groups. Additionally, because H1N1 influenza vaccine is provided at no cost to pharmacies, the public will not be charged for the vaccine itself. However, there will be a small charge for the administration of the vaccine. Insurance companies may cover this cost.
